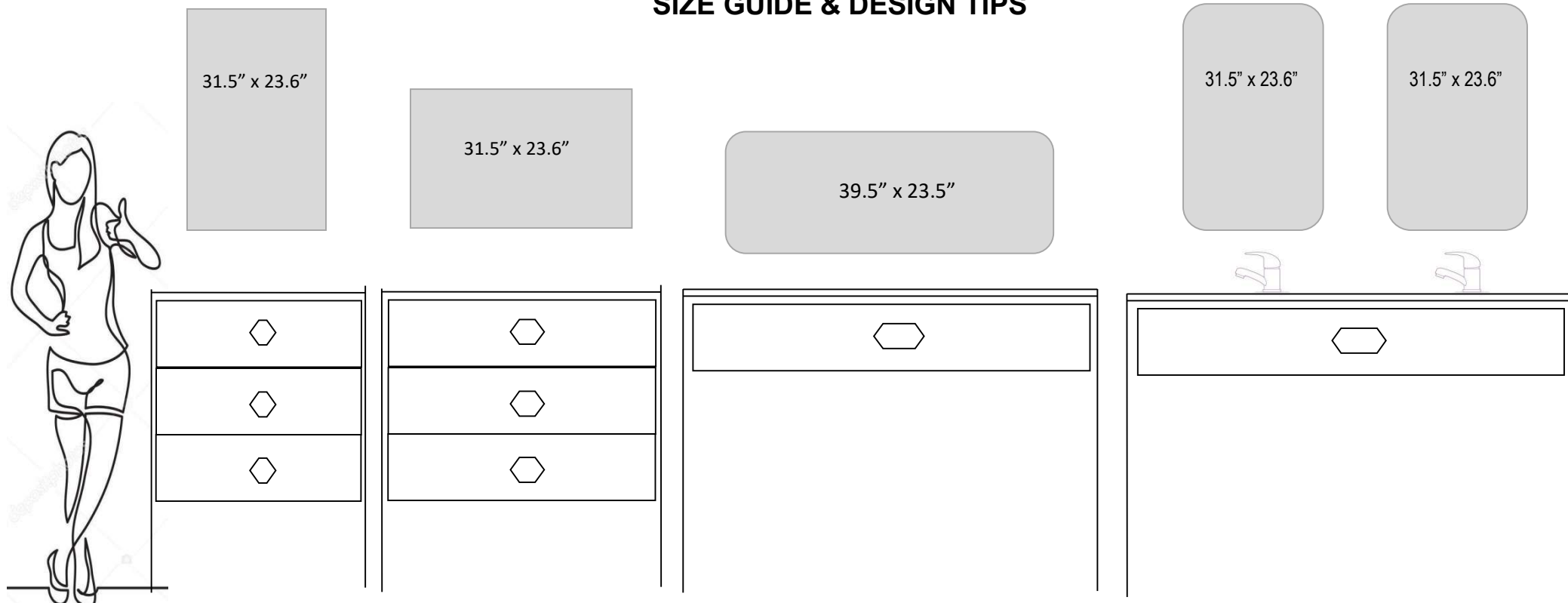


MIRRORS BY DW

SIZE GUIDE & DESIGN TIPS



INTERIOR DESIGNER TIPS

- ⚡ When hanging your mirror above a vanity, console table, arm chair or fire place – place it 6” – 8” above the visual line. In bathrooms this will protect your mirror from water splashes
- ⚡ Choose a mirror that is 1”-2” smaller than the width of the countertop of your bathroom vanity
- ⚡ Make sure the mirror is **tall enough** so your head doesn’t get cut off when looking into it
- ⚡ When hanging above a nightstand, center the mirror above the night stand
- ⚡ When hanging on a blank wall, place it so the vertical center is at eye level- usually 60” from the floor
- ⚡ Hang your mirror with a friend so you can ‘eyeball’ your placement standing a few feet back
- ⚡ ADA COMPLIANT MIRRORS – Hang the mirror with the bottom edge no higher than 40” off the ground
- ⚡ *Most rectangular mirrors featured can be hung horizontally and vertically unless otherwise noted*
